- WHEREAS, Bay County, along the Bay City Public Schools, is a partner in the operations of Bay 3 TV; and
- WHEREAS, Since the inception of the Bay 3 TV Partnership, the contract period has been one year at a time, coinciding with the fiscal year of the managing partner which is the Bay City Public Schools; and
- WHEREAS, Each year in March or April, the partners are requested to approve a new contract and a proposed contract covering the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 has been submitted; and
- WHEREAS, The contribution for Bay County (and the other partner) went to \$41,000 three years ago; and
- WHEREAS, The first 50% of the new contract period has been budgeted (along with the last 50% of the current year) in the Recreation and Administrative Services budget; and
- WHEREAS, Approval of the one year contract extension will commit the County to a 2nd 50% payment in the first six months of 2012; and
- WHEREAS, When the City of Bay City withdrew, working with Superintendent of the Bay City Public Schools Doug Newcombe, the \$41,000 from each of the remaining partners stayed at \$41,000; and
- WHEREAS, While a detailed budget has been requested, it has not yet been received and this recommendation is predicated on a status quo budget and County funding of \$41,000; Therefore, Be It
- RESOLVED That the Bay County Board of Commissioners approves the contract with the other Bay 3 TV Partner for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$41,000, subject to concurrence at the same level by the Bay City Public Schools; Be It Further
- RESOLVED That the Chairman of the Board is authorized to execute said contract on behalf of Bay County following legal review/approval; Be It Finally

 WHEREAS, Funding is available through the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) to support a comprehensive 24/7 Tobacco-Free School Policy Initiative that will include newly emerging tobacco and non-tobacco nicotine products and the purpose of the grant is to assist schools in adopting this policy; and

BY: WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE (6/5/12)
 WHEREAS, For several years, County represented and non-represented employees have borne a 15% cost contribution to their health care coverage, long before most counties; and
 WHEREAS, County employees have not had a raise in base pay since 2008 however their monetary contribution to health care continues to increase with inflation; and
 WHEREAS, Bargaining units in Bay County have agreed to a managed prescription drug care plan which will in some cases increase the cost to employees; and
 WHEREAS, The unions have agreed to provisions concerning new hires which should provide savings in the future; and
 WHEREAS, On September 27, 2011, Act 152, Public Acts of 2011, became effective and provided, among other items, that the employer shall bear no more than 80% of total health care costs (Section 3 of the Act) unless, "Sec 8.(1) By a 2/3 vote of its governing body each year, a local unit of government exempt itself from the requirements of this act for the succeeding year."; and
 WHEREAS, This provision is made as part of the consideration of the agreements reached with the County's various bargaining units for contracts governing calendar years 2012 - 2013; and
 WHEREAS, Continuation of the 5%/15% allocation of health care costs for 2013 should have little impact on the budget for 2013 and the changes in the managed prescription drug plan should provide a savings over the projected increase in that plan; and
 WHEREAS, The waiver by the unions of a wage increase (total 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013) justifies continuing the 85/15 allocation through 2013; Therefore, Be It
 RESOLVED That the Bay County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to Sec. 8.(1) of Public Act 152 of 2011, hereby exempts itself of the requirements of P.A. 152 of 2011 for the calendar year 2013 and continues the 85/15 allocation of health care costs through 2013 for employees represented by unions with ratified collective bargaining agreements for 2012 - 2013 and for non-represented employees and elected officials.
