



Stay on the Safe Side. Lock Up Medical Marijuana.

Storing medical marijuana products safely is essential. Medical marijuana products can be easily mistaken for food or candy. Locking it up and storing it safely keeps your medication out of the wrong hands.

In Michigan, emergency room visits due to cannabis-related effects are increasing.

Proper storage helps eliminate emergency room visits and other issues related to medical marijuana that occur when it is used by someone other than the patient. Using lockbox and keeping medical marijuana out of sight (preferably in an up-high place) is necessary for proper storage.

Key reasons to use a medical marijuana lockbox:

- · Keeps children of all ages safe
- Inhibits teen experimentation
- Safeguards against Child Protective Services issues
- Helps prevent the accidental poisoning of children and pets

According to the National Capital Poison Center, there are no regulations for medical marijuana storage, such as warning labels or child-resistant packaging.

It is up to patients to safely store their medical marijuana and keep it out of the reach of children.

Signs a Child Consumed Medical Marijuana

- Difficulty Breathing
- Dizziness
- Feeling Tired
- Trouble Sitting Up
- Slowed Breathing
- Trouble Walking
