Proper storage and use of medical marijuana products is essential to ensure the safety of others.

Use It Responsibly, Store It Responsibly

Medical marijuana patients are responsible for the safe usage and handling of their medication. Mishandling medical marijuana can have serious consequences – including car accidents and stolen medication.

In the State of Michigan, medical marijuana is legal for adults over age 18.

According to a report published in 2020 by the University of Michigan:

- Young adults ages 18-25 are the age group with the highest percentage of cannabis use
- Cannabis trends are higher in Michigan than the rest of the Midwest and the U.S. – these increases correlate with the legalization of medical marijuana in 2008
- 3% of the population in Michigan uses medical marijuana
- More than 43,000 people are registered as caregivers to provide medical marijuana for qualified patients
